Further to your letter dated 31<sup>st</sup> December 2014, We are content that the Highways Agency's engagement with this authority has met the requirements of the Planning Act. We also note that the HA has held a number of events/meetings in Suffolk (as recorded in Appendix D of the Consultation Report) at the County Council's and other local stakeholders' requests, which have been useful.

We note that the Consultation Report (in particular Appendix E) records the feedback that the County Council has submitted and outlines the Highway Agency's response to this, including whether or not changes to the scheme have been made. While we consider therefore that the Consultation Report meets the relevant requirements, we are not necessarily in agreement with the Highway Agency's position on some matters and thus may wish to pursue this through future written and oral representations as need be.
