

Dear Mr Coombes,

Thank you for the information regarding the preliminary meeting.

I would like to attend.

I may wish to speak but, as my point is only a general one, if it is raised by others or dealt with in advance I will not need to do so.

The point which I would like to raise is the difficulty of locating specific information within the applicants documents.

The information portal shows, currently, a total of 796 documents of which 764 are described as being the developer's application. There does not, however, appear to be any concise index or guide to allow interested parties to quickly search for information specific to their parcel of land or point of interest etc.

It will make it very difficult for any interested party to participate in the Examination process, on a level playing field, when it is extremely difficult and time-consuming to find where relevant details are contained in such a large volume of documents.

It would be very helpful if the applicant would produce a detailed index to the documentation and if the web portal was set up to allow a direct link to any document from that index (rather than having to trawl consecutively from page to page).
