Dear Mr Coombes,

Thank you for your email dated 17<sup>th</sup> April 2015 regarding details relating to the Notice of Preliminary Meeting to be held on Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> May 2015 at Commemoration Hall, 39 High Street, Huntingdon.

I am pleased to confirm that the District Council wishes to attend this meeting.

I would also confirm that on behalf of the District Council, I wish to speak on the Deadlines for the Submission of:

- Hunts DC/Highways England Statement of Common Ground
- Joint Local Impact Report
- Hunts DC Written Representation

Due to our current period of 'Purdah' relating to local District elections to be held on 7<sup>th</sup> May, our final democratic consideration of the 3 documents listed above, will not take place until our first formal Scrutiny Panel and Cabinet to be held after these elections as follows;

- Overview & Scrutiny Panel – 9<sup>th</sup> June 2015
- Cabinet – 18<sup>th</sup> June 2015

Following Cabinet and in accordance with our constitution, the Council has up to 3 working days in which to publish the recommended decisions of Cabinet, namely until 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2015. A 5-working day 'Call-In' period then applies to those recommendations, namely until 30<sup>th</sup> June 2015. The Council therefore wishes to advise the Preliminary Meeting that this Council will not be able to meet the current submission deadline of 15<sup>th</sup> June and that our submission date will be on 26<sup>th</sup>, 29<sup>th</sup> or 30<sup>th</sup> June 2015.

As PINS will be aware, the Joint Local Impact Report is a document being produced between this Council, Cambridgeshire County Council, South Cambridgeshire District Council and Cambridge City Council. Our deadlines as outlined will therefore impact on the submission of this Joint LIR and we will therefore seek an extension to the timescale submission for this document, plus the two others that specifically relate to this Council.

I trust that this is in order.
