Thank you for your email dated 17th April 2015 regarding details relating to the Notice of Preliminary Meeting to be held on Wednesday 13th May 2015 at Commemoration Hall, 39 High Street, Huntingdon.

I am pleased to confirm that District Council officers wish to attend this meeting.

As PINS will already be aware, the Local Authorities (this Council, Cambridgeshire County Council, Huntingdonshire District Council and Cambridge City Council) are producing a Joint Local Impact Report (LIR).

Huntingdonshire District Council has informed PINs of their democratic processes deadline, which will extend until the end of June 2015. This will therefore impact on the submission of the Joint LIR and the Councils will therefore seek an extension to the submission timescale for this document.
