

Our concerns are about the proposed new road scheme providing access to Huntingdon Railway Station and the associated car park area.

Request for a site visit

I believe a site visit would help the Panel to appreciate the problems of the station area and to understand the problems that the scheme, without major modifications, will present to residents of Station Cottages.

I suggest you use the existing footpath to the south of Station Cottages that is accessible from the station car park and also call at 9, Station Cottages to view the area from a different perspective. You will see from the plans of the proposed new road that it will run within a few yards of our rear garden boundary.

The close proximity of Station Cottages to the proposed new car park access road and to the A14 should also be considered as detrimental to the wellbeing of residents of Station Cottages.

The necessity for substantial barriers between Station Cottages and both the proposed car park access road and a de-trunked A14 to mitigate the impact of noise, air and light pollution, and provide security for residents if the scheme proceeds. Unfortunately, these will destroy the present pleasant views of the local area and induce a feeling of enclosure.
