A14 Cambridge to Huntingdon Highway Improvement Scheme – Ref: TR010018
Request for Site Visit – Peter Mann, Lodge Farm

I write in respect of the above matter to request a site visit for the following reasons:

- The proposed Highway is to be constructed within 150 metres of a dwelling, and 100m of livestock buildings.
- Peter Mann stands to lose 20% of his total holding on a permanent basis, and up to 30% during the construction phase.
- The highway will dissect the holding in half, reducing its productive farming capacity significantly.
- A large area of arable land is designated to be acquired for flood alleviation and attenuation purposes, when there are obvious less valuable areas which could be acquired to fulfil the requirements.
- This scheme could potentially cause numerous security risks for Lodge Farm.
- Peter Mann has extensive local knowledge of the area, and it is felt that this has not been utilised efficiently.
