**A14 Cambridge to Huntingdon Highway Improvement Scheme – Ref: TR0118**  
**Request for Site Visit -My Client : Basil King**

I write in respect of Basil King as an interested party, who is affected by the A14 Cambridge to Huntingdon Improvement Scheme.

I hereby request a site visit on his behalf to two particular locations:-

**Views Common, Huntingdon**

- An original access was proposed off the roundabout connecting the de-trunked A14 to the Views Common Link. This was subsequently removed and placed on what promises to be an extremely busy highway, and it is believed that this proposes a risk to road users, pedestrians and agricultural traffic.
- There are considerable unsubstantiated designations for Ecological Mitigation Areas,

**Debden Farm**

- A soil storage area has been proposed for Plots 12/2A and 11/8A. Within the field is a carp pond, currently fed by land drainage. Should this soil store be used, then the land drains would no longer be able to function due to the pressure, causing concerns about the animal welfare of the carp. This has not been addressed by Highways England.

I trust the above will be of significant interest to warrant a site visit and we look forward to hearing from the Planning Inspectorate in due course.
