Subject: Request for site Visit Land Below and Adjacent A14 Viaduct, Brampton Road Huntingdon

Dear Sirs

We refer to Deadline 1 of the Examination Timetable of the A14 scheme and Location for Accompanied site visits and request the inspector visit our lands adjacent and surrounding the Viaduct, Brampton Road, Huntingdon.

Whilst we appreciate the Applicant is seeking a Temporary Occupation of these lands we draw your attention to our previous comments to these plans which questions the extent of land proposed to remove the viaduct structure. We draw your attention to the previous application which was extensively rehearsed by the applicants then appointed specialist contractor who identified the extent of land required. The failure of the applicant to identify sufficient working areas and means of access to site now will create uncertainty for us leading up to implementation, further unnecessary latter negotiation and potential uncertainty and delays to completing this important part of the scheme on time.

We understand the applicant has only recently appointed a specialist consultant to examine and report on the methodology for dismantling the viaduct. We believe these works should have been completed at a much earlier stage.

We request to Inspector attend site to witness first hand the logistical restrictions relating to these works
