- We wish to see the data on pollution/congestion levels that affect Lolworth once the scheme is finalised
- Please confirm HE will keep its promise to undertake noise reduction measures using the most up to date technology
- We wish to see details of how traffic entering and leaving Lolworth be managed during the construction of the scheme. In particular, we want confirmation that it will not involve “escorted traffic” through the road works
- What is the justification for the width of the NMU from Lolworth to the Cambridge Services to be the minimum for a combined pedestrian and cycle path when horses will use it as well?
- What is the justification for the alignment of the NMU from Lolworth to the Cambridge Services when on grounds of noise, pollution and safety, it could be diverted in a more northerly direction from the flyover to the rear of the Little Chef (the current route has to be diverted at this point due to a lack of space even allowing for minimum distances).
