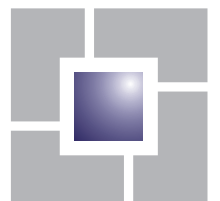

- 1.0 This Written Representation has been prepared by David Tucker Associates on behalf of Whitbread Group PLC (A14-AFP374).
 - 2.0 The company are occupiers on land with Plot ref 5/29b. It is not clear what purpose long term for this land is, and clarification has been sought from Highways England (HE).
 - 3.0 Whitbread Group PLC object to the scheme in relation to the changes at Brampton Hut Services. HE have indicated that there is no requirement to acquire any land from the company. Until this such time as this has been confirmed, Whitbread Group PLC object to the CPO and DCO on the basis that it has a potentially significant adverse impact on the company's operations.
 - 4.0 In addition, the revised highway layout will remove A14 traffic from the Brampton Hut junction, through the creation of a bypass link. The facility is currently signed from all approaches (A14 and A1). It is therefore essential that appropriate signing is provided for A14 traffic to the facility. The objector requests details of the proposed signing for review and further comment.
 - 5.0 Whitbread Group Plc have an interest in Plot refs 21/18, 22/3a, 22/3b, 22/3c, 22/9, 22/13, 22/18.
 - 6.0 Whitbread Group Plc's position in in respect of 27/16, 27/19 and 27/20 reflect those made by Premier Inn (A14_AFP182) and the position in respect of those land areas are provided in DTA response 17233-01_WR_Premier Inn. They are not repeated here.
