I wish to ask whether , in the process of earlier planning , relevant details in both the Hilton Village Design Statement of 2006 and later our Parish Plan were taken into account . The VDS was accepted as Supplementary Planning Guidance by Huntingdon District Council and you will find that in both documents the issue of greatest concern was the amount of vehicular traffic on the B1040 . I believe the people of Hilton would expect you to have heeded this . The traffic flow since then has increased(viz speedwatch statistics) and concerns continue , especially regarding the number of HGVs . You are expected to take steps to alleviate the effect both during and after construction . I urge you to study the VDS and the Parish Plan.
