Please accept this email as my formal intention to speak at the above meeting.

My question is as follows:

"What additional measures have been decided to mitigate the environmental impacts of the proposed new A14 on Hilton, given the increase in scale of the road and the unilateral decision to move the project significantly closer to the village than has ever been consulted on and, what traffic management measures will be put in place to restrict heavy traffic using the minor rural roads of the village and thus prevent the consequent damage any increase in such traffic will cause?"

I have a supplementary question concerning due process:

"How can contracts for building the new A14 be awarded when, as I understand it, you and the Planning Inspectorate are still in the process of consultation and no final decision has been made?"

I regret that I did not log this question as an "interested party" as the inconceivable was inconceivable at the time.
