Dear Mr Coombes,

Further to my conversation on Friday afternoon with your colleague I can confirm that we had a productive meeting with Highways England on Friday regarding the scheme. In relation to the CPO I can confirm that Extra fully support proposed change DR1.21 of the CPO boundary and that the change has been agreed between Extra and HE. This will be formally documented in the SOCG shortly but in the meantime I can confirm that we no longer feel it necessary to take up the Panel's time tomorrow (2nd September) and therefore will not attending the session.

I note that the proposed boundary change is subject to wider consultation and our position set out above is predicated on the assumption that change DR1.21 is indeed confirmed.

In the event that any party raises objection to the amendment we would reserve our right to comment further. In the event that the amendment is not confirmed, our formal position is as set out in Section 3 of our Written Representation.

Finally, although all matters in respect of the CPO boundary are agreed with the promoters, we are in ongoing dialogue regarding traffic and detailed design matters. We would therefore like to confirm attendance at the sessions on the 16th / 17th. Whilst the outstanding issues overlap both matters, it may be better for all parties if our attendance was limited to one of the two days.

I would be grateful if you could confirm receipt.
