Re A14/A1 Highways scheme

I have been approached by my constituent, Mrs Maria Hugh [REDACTED]

Mrs. Hugh submitted a written representation dated 10 June 2015 identifying issues regarding noise impacts to her listed residential property. Her letter also detailed her request for an acoustic bund.

My understanding is that the current position is that there is to be a quieter road surface and that Highways England are not prepared to build a bund.

This noise has been of great concern to my constituent who strongly maintains that without a bund her quality of life will be significantly reduced. The trouble is very much exacerbated by the fact that her property is old and not suitable for double glazing.

In addition, Mrs. Hugh now understands that there is a proposal to construct a bridleway across the A1 boundary with her property. Again, Mrs. Hugh does not feel this an appropriate proposal in the context of her property and her right to privacy, as her property is very close to the proposed works.

I hope you will give further consideration to my constituent's concerns.
