For Deadline 15, I have only one further point to make. My previous representations still stand.

Reading the responses of Highways England ("HE") throughout the Examination process, it seems that they rely substantially on compliance with the minimum requirements of the Design Manual for Roads and Bridges ("DMRB"). I believe that the remit of the ExA goes further than merely ensuring compliance with DMRB otherwise there would be little or no point in consulting interested parties during the Examination period as they could not hope to influence the outcomes materially. Accordingly, I do hope that you will be able to give due regard to my representations whether or not they imply actions beyond the requirements of DMRB.
