The hearing will commence at 12.00 noon, immediately following the issue specific hearing dealing with matters relating to the draft Development Consent Order which is being held on the same day. All interested parties are welcome to attend the hearing. However, affected persons whose land interests are affected under compulsory acquisition proposals are specifically invited to attend.
