Rule 6 Application by the Highways Agency (now Highways England) for an Order Granting Development Consent for the proposed M4 Junctions 3 to 12 Smart Motorway

I am instructed to write to you following our Quarterly General Meeting where it was agreed that the above plans represent a major threat to Cranford Country Park and Conservation Area and we are seeking to attend an accompanied site visit and speak at an open floor hearing.

As it is unlikely that we will have a representative at your Preliminary Meeting, we thought it advisable to give notice of our request. We will be making a more formal request with the necessary detail in due course. We are liaising with Robin Brown of the Hayes Community Development Forum (interested party 10031720) and Justine Bayley, chair of Heathrow Villages Conservation Areas Advisory Panel (interested party 10031728).

Our preference for the timing of a hearing is 17 to 18 November (evening). A local venue may well be available and we would invite other local interested parties to attend. The Hayes Community Development Forum and Heathrow Villages Conservation Areas Advisory Panel representatives are in agreement.

Regarding the site visit (10 to 12 November) we would like this to address not only Cranford Park on both sides of the M4 but also the public footpath to Harlington High Street overbridge and thence to the Recreation Ground at Shepiston Lane and via the public subway to Church of St Peter & Paul, St Peter's Way, Harlington. The Committee looks forward to your favourable response to this request.
