Dear Sirs

Following Mr Williams' email below, I wish to formally nominate for the Inspectors' ASI on 6 December 2016 the area at the south end of the proposed Silvertown Tunnel from Tunnel Approach round through Dreadnought Street and Boord Street into Millennium Way, including around Studio 338, the Evening Standard operations centre, the present footbridge over Tunnel Approach and, as far as it may be accessible, the National Grid/ Southern Gas Networks site with the gas holder. Studio 338 and their plans will affect all these sites and they are therefore highly relevant to TfL's need for land at the southern end of the proposed tunnel and the knowledge of the sites the inspectors would obtain from actually visiting would greatly help us in making representations.

I have asked the Evening Standard to provide access to their site and they have agreed, however I would be grateful if you could in due course confirm attendees for security reasons.

I believe I have already been included on the list of those joining the visit but, if not, please include me. I understand that our adviser Angela Schembri and Charles Whitworth, adviser to National Grid/ Southern Gas Networks would also like to be included.
