Dear Emre Williams (Case Manager),

Further to the letter from the Examining Authority (ExA) (dated 19/12/16) providing notification of hearings and accompanied site inspection, HSE (SILV-354) confirms our wish to attend two hearings.

1. Issue Specific Hearing on Air Quality, Noise and Other Environmental Issues – 18/1/17

As notified at Deadline 1, The Health and Safety Executive (HSE) wishes to make oral representations at the Issue Specific Hearing (ISH) on air quality, noise and other environmental issues. If, and to the extent that, the outstanding issues have not been agreed with the applicant HSE intends to speak at this ISH in order to:

- (a) explain its unchallenged advice to 'Advise Against' the proposed Southern tunnel approach within the consultation Inner Zones (highest level of residual risk) of two major hazard sites, in particular relating to the hazard safety areas around the two major hazard sites (which are subject to Hazardous Substances Consent) and the zoning for public safety that HSE has attached to those safety areas;
- (b) outline the proposed solutions (modifications or revocations of the relevant hazardous substances consent), which may change HSE's advice, but which have not been achieved as yet and are not in HSE's gift to bring about;
- (c) explain the necessity for a suitable Requirement, equivalent to a 'Grampian' condition;

if appropriate at this ISH, to discuss suitable wording for such a Requirement;

respond to any technical or other questions the ExA or the parties may have.

The intention is for Ms Yates to introduce HSE's oral representations and for Ms Fearon and Dr Harper to be available to answer technical questions and participate in any discussions, where necessary.

2. Issue Specific Hearing on the Development Consent Order – 19/1/17

HSE wishes to ensure that the above points are reflected in the DCO and confirms that it will be represented at this ISH.

If, and to the extent that, the HSE's requested draft Requirement has not been addressed at the ISH on 18/1/17, HSE intends to speak on that issue. It may also wish to comment if any relevant points arise during the discussion of other aspects of the draft DCO.
