It is noted that the ExA has requested an indication of the reason why particular sites should be inspected. The reasons for the PLA's requests are:

(a)	the proposed route of the tunnel across the river and the affected areas of the river	To (i) see the extent of the land within the Order limits (ii) appreciate the water areas under which the tunnel will run (iii) understand what land is to be used for construction and maintenance (iv) see the affected moorings, wharves and other facilities in and adjoining the river
(b)	the adjoining river walls on the north bank of the river	To see the river walls which may be subject to CA powers
(c)	Thames Wharf	To see the extent of the proposed land take/use and the current uses of the wharf
(d)	Peruvian Wharf	To see the impacts of the proposals on access to this safeguarded wharf
(e)	Tidal Basin Roundabout and the adjoining roads in particular as affording access to Peruvian Wharf and Thames Wharf	As (d)
