Application by Transport for London for a Development Consent Order for the proposed Silvertown Tunnel

We act on behalf of BL CW Holdings Limited, an interested party in respect of the above application. Please note that King & Wood Mallesons is no longer instructed by our client on this matter so please would you direct all correspondence going forward to Herbert Smith Freehills.

In accordance with the procedural timetable, Transport for London submitted a suite of documents to the Planning Inspectorate on 14 December 2016 for Deadline 2. That contained information on the proposals for the monitoring and mitigation strategies for the proposed Silvertown Tunnel. This was submitted, in part, in response to requests for information set out in BL CW Holdings Limited's written representation dated 15 November 2016.

BL CW Holdings Limited has been informed by Transport for London that it intends to submit further information to address concerns raised by BL CW Holdings Limited for Deadline 3 on 27 January 2017.

We are writing to request an opportunity for BL CW Holdings Limited to submit a further written representation to the Examining Authority after Deadline 3. That representation would include BL CW Holdings Limited's comments on the material submitted by Transport for London for Deadlines 2 and 3 and identify any issues that remain unresolved. We should be grateful if you would please confirm if this would be acceptable to the Examining Authority and, if so, the deadline for submitting this representation.

It may be necessary for Transport for London to make amendments to the draft monitoring and mitigation strategies following receipt of BL CW Holdings Limited's comments in the further representation. We consider that that it would be appropriate for these amendments to be submitted for Deadline 4 or Deadline 5, depending on what deadline is set for submission of BL CW Holdings Limited's further representation. Please would you confirm.
