Our client: Trinity (D) Limited ("Trinity D")

Trinity D is currently in the process of negotiating with Transport for London ("TfL"), and other interested parties, mitigation measures in relation to replacement car parking at the O2 Arena (the "Final Agreement").

Trinity D is aware that TfL has written (by letter dated 12 January 2017) to the Examining Authority proposing changes to the proposals contained in the DCO application (the "Change Application") which includes changes to the proposed replacement car parking solution at the O2 Arena. Subject to the completion of a suitable Final Agreement, Trinity D supports the car parking proposals set out within the Change Application and, in order not to prejudice the negotiation of the Final Agreement, does not propose to make any submissions to the Examining Authority at the forthcoming Compulsory Acquisition Hearing on 20 January 2017.

However, as the Final Agreement is not yet finalised, Trinity D reserves its right to make further submissions and representations, without restriction, and maintains all of its representations made to date in relation to the Scheme for the time being.
