Dear Sirs,

In accordance with the Examination Timetable for the above project and the Examining Authority's letter of 10 February 2017, please find below the written submissions of our client, Brenntag UK Limited (also representing the interests of Brenntag Inorganic Chemicals Limited), at Deadline 4.

**Response to Examining Authority's Second Written Questions – CA2 and CA4**

- Negotiations between our client and Transport for London (TfL) in relation to the detailed terms of a Land and Works Agreement are ongoing. Both parties are working towards securing an agreement on all matters prior to the close of the Examination, however, we must point out that the concern raised on behalf of our client in connection with its request for an additional product storage area, which concern was summarised orally at the compulsory acquisition hearing on 20 January 2017 and explained in further detail in our Deadline 3 written submissions (a further copy of which are attached for ease of reference), remains, with no proposals being put forward by TfL to address it. Accordingly, our client is not yet in a position to withdraw the representations it has made to date in respect of TfL's application for a development consent order.

**Application for Hazardous Substances Consent (ref. 12/1247/H) – Further Update**

- Our client's updated Flood Risk Assessment was submitted to the London Borough of Greenwich ("the Council") on 14 February 2017. We understand that the updated Assessment is in the process of being consulted upon. Provided this consultation exercise does not give rise to any major issues, and subject to ongoing discussions regarding the manner in which a consent (assuming a positive determination by the Council) may be conditioned, we would hope that the Council will be in a position to determine our client's application by the end of this month (i.e. March 2017).

**Attendance at Hearings w/c 27 March 2017**

- Pending the outcome of our client's ongoing discussions with TfL, we are instructed to reserve their right to attend and make oral representations at the following hearings:

- Compulsory Acquisition Hearing – 29 March 2017 (AM)
- Issue Specific Hearing in relation to the draft DCO – 29 March 2017 (PM)

Should it prove necessary for our client to attend the above-mentioned Compulsory Acquisition Hearing (in which regard, please note that our client's interested party reference number is 255), it will wish to speak and make oral representations in respect of Plots 01-027, 01-028, 01-030 and 01-050. It may also wish to speak and make oral representations in respect of proposed Plots 01-027a, 01-050a, 01-057a and 01-057b, all of which are the subject of TfL's request for a non-material change – specifically NMC1. The provisions of the draft DCO in which our client takes an interest and on which they may wish to comment will be confirmed in advance of 29 March (and by no later than 12 noon on 21 March 2017), assuming our client's attendance at this Issue Specific Hearing is required.
