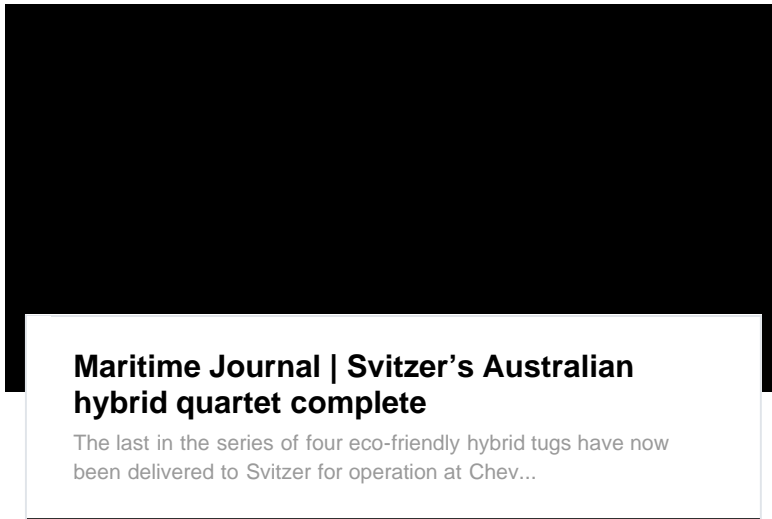
I note that several new documents relating to the Silvertown Tunnel have been published earlier this month.

With regard to Air Quality, there appears to be no assessment of the air quality impact of the vessels operating on the River Thames in support of this project.

I have looked at the Environmental Assessments and cannot find any reference to their impact on air quality.

Vessels on the Thames have little in the way of emission mitigation. Other projects in air quality sensitive areas around the world have used vessels that meet more stringent standards. Why not for London?
