I live at [REDACTED] I came to the open floor hearing last week where [REDACTED] Rebecca Moore spoke on behalf of Siebert Road making several very strong points regarding the noise and pollution and why we must have a noise and pollution barrier down Westcombe Hill, Siebert Road and Invicta Road.
