**PLANNING ACT 2008
APPLICATION FOR DEVELOPMENT CONSENT FOR THE PROPOSED SILVERTOWN TUNNEL
(REF: TR010021) ("THE SCHEME")
BRENNTAG UK LIMITED (ALSO REPRESENTING THE INTERESTS OF BRENNTAG INORGANIC
CHEMICALS LIMITED) (INTERESTED PARTY REF: 255)**

We write further to the above matter in respect of which we are instructed to act on behalf of Brenntag UK Limited (also representing the interests of Brenntag Inorganic Chemicals Limited) (referred to hereinafter together as the "**Brenntag Companies**").

We confirm that the Brenntag Companies have today entered into a Land and Works Agreement relating to Transport for London's ("**TfL**") application for development consent ("**the DCO application**") in relation to the Scheme, and specific measures intended to mitigate the anticipated impacts of the Silvertown Tunnel proposals, namely accommodation works in respect of the existing car park, the primary and secondary/emergency vehicular access and egress points, and the pedestrian access/egress and circulation arrangements at our clients' operational chemical storage and distribution facility at no. 215 Tunnel Avenue, Greenwich ("**the Greenwich Site**").

Subject to TfL complying with the terms of the above-mentioned Land and Works Agreement, and in light of the non-material changes proposed to the Scheme (in particular, 'NMC1'), which non-material changes were formally accepted by the Examining Authority at the Compulsory Acquisition Hearing which took place on 29 March 2017, we confirm the withdrawal of the representations made on behalf of the Brenntag Companies in respect of the DCO application and the anticipated impacts of the Silvertown Tunnel proposals on the continuing operation of the Greenwich site to the Examining Authority.

Furthermore, we confirm that the Brenntag Companies do not propose to make any further representations to the Examining Authority prior to the close of the Examination on 11 April 2017.
