Dear Secretary of State,

The Newham Friends of the Earth Group would like to reiterate serious concerns expressed earlier in the consultation and detailed recently (23 August) by national Friends of the Earth about the danger to air quality from increased traffic passing through a Silvertown Tunnel with harm to local residents and workers. Air quality experiments carried out around London (particularly near major roads) have made the problem clear.

The 11 page response from the applicants has an opaque style, presents (on pages 7 and 9) two enigmatic tables and refers overwhelmingly to preceding documents. I therefore ask that the consultation period be extended by a month to allow study of it in context.
