Thank you for consulting Historic England on the proposed Silvertown Tunnel Order, and the request for comments from the interested parties in respect of the Updated Air Quality Assessment and supporting Emission Factor Toolkit v8 Drawings, dated 26 February 2018.

As the government's adviser on all matters relating to the historic environment, our objective is to ensure that the conservation of the historic environment is fully taken into account at all stages of the Silvertown Tunnel's development.

We have reviewed the documents and as our expertise relates specifically to the historic environment we are content for the impact of the assessments to be determined on the basis of the advice of those environmental bodies best placed to assess such impacts. We do not therefore wish to comment in this instance.

However, if you consider the documentation to have specific impacts for the historic environment we would be happy to offer further advice.

Finally, we should like to stress that this opinion is based on the information provided by TfL in its submission. To avoid any doubt, this does not affect our obligation to provide further advice and, potentially, object to specific proposals, which may subsequently arise where we consider that these would have an adverse effect upon the historic environment.
