1. Introduction

- 1.1.1 This document relates to an application by Highways England to the Secretary of State for Transport under the Planning Act 2008, as amended by the Localism Act 2011 (the Application), for the Highways England A38 Derby Junctions scheme (referred to herein as “the Scheme”) Development Consent Order.
- 1.1.2 This document has been prepared in compliance with the requirements of Regulation 5(2)(l) of the Infrastructure Planning (Applications: Prescribed Forms and Procedure) Regulations 2009, which requires:
- “Where applicable, a plan with accompanying information identifying –*
- (i) any statutory or non-statutory sites or features of nature conservation such as sites of geological or landscape importance.*
- together with an assessment of any effects on such sites, features, habitats or bodies likely to be caused by the proposed development.”*
- 1.1.3 This document has been prepared in accordance with the Department for Communities and Local Government guidance, ‘Planning Act 2008: Application form guidance’ (June 2013).
- 1.1.4 As this document is part of a suite of documents, it should be read alongside and is informed by the other Application documents. In particular, this document should be read alongside the Environmental Statement [TR010022/APP/6.1].
- 1.1.5 Statutory designated sites of nature conservation importance are shown on Environmental Statement Figure 8.3 [TR010022/APP/6.2], whilst non-statutory sites of nature conservation importance are shown on Environmental Statement Figures 8.4 and 8.5 [TR010022/APP/6.2].
- 1.1.6 An assessment of the Scheme effects on habitats, protected species and other biodiversity features is provided in Environmental Statement Chapter 8: Biodiversity [TR010022/APP/6.1].
- 1.1.7 Detailed survey reports, baseline reports and other technical information referenced within Environmental Statement Chapter 8: Biodiversity [TR010022/APP/6.1] are provided as appendices in [TR010022/APP/6.3] (Appendices 8.1 through 8.20).
- 1.1.8 An assessment of the Scheme effects on geological features is presented in Environmental Statement Chapter 10: Geology and Soils [TR010022/APP/6.1] - relevant geological features are illustrated in Environmental Statement Figures 10.1 to 10.3 [TR010022/APP/6.2].
