1. Introduction

1.1.1 This document relates to an application by Highways England to the Secretary of State for Transport under the Planning Act 2008, as amended by the Localism Act 2011 (the Application), for the Highways England A38 Derby Junctions scheme (referred to herein as “the Scheme”) Development Consent Order.

1.1.2 This document has been prepared in compliance with the requirements of Regulation 5(2)(m) of the Infrastructure Planning (Applications: Prescribed Forms and Procedure) Regulations 2009, which requires:

“where applicable, a plan with accompanying information identifying any statutory or non-statutory sites or features of the historic environment, including scheduled monuments, World Heritage sites, listed buildings and other historic structures, archaeological sites and registered battlefields, together with an assessment of any effects on such sites, features or structures likely to be caused by the proposed development.”

1.1.3 This document has also been prepared in accordance with the Department for Communities and Local Government guidance, ‘Planning Act 2008: Application form guidance’ (June 2013).

1.1.4 As this document is part of a suite of documents, it should be read alongside and is informed by the other Application documents. In particular, this document should be read alongside the Environmental Statement [TR010022/APP/6.1].
