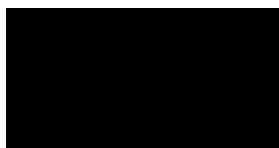

It will comprise the creation of three new grade separated junctions at the three existing roundabout junctions at the A38/A5111 at Kingsway, the A38/A52 at Markeaton and the A38/A61 at Little Eaton, with road widening in either direction (from 2 lanes to 3 lanes) between Kingsway junction and Kedleston road junction. The project is located within the administrative boundaries of Derby City Council, Erewash Borough Council and Derbyshire County Council.

The deadline date for all representations to be received by the Planning Inspectorate under section 56 was 5 August 2019.
