On behalf of Network Rail we note:

1. Network Rail do not propose to attend the Preliminary Meeting on 8 October.
2. Network Rail do not propose to attend Issue Specific Hearing 1 on the Development Consent Order on 8 October.
3. In relation to the Examining Authority's question number 79 set out in "The Examining Authority's issues and questions for the Issue Specific Hearing 1 dealing with matters relating to the draft Development Consent Order" [PD-003]:
"79. Part 4 – For the Protection of Network Rail

(a) Have these provisions been agreed with Network Rail?
(b) What matters, if any, are still subject to agreement and what steps are being taken to resolve them?"

On behalf of Network Rail it is noted in relation to the above questions that:

- (a) The Protective Provisions in Part 4 of Schedule 9 of the draft Development Consent Order have not been agreed.
- (b) Representatives of Network Rail are in contact with the Applicant and it is anticipated that discussions in relation to Network Rail's preferred form of Protective Provisions will commence shortly.

The Examining Authority will be kept updated with the progress of discussions between the parties and Written Representations will be submitted in accordance with the Examination timetable.
