## **Statements of Common Ground**

The following Statements of Common Ground are not in a suitably advanced form to be submitted as a draft version, because substantive agreement has not yet been reached, or the document is still subject to review by one of the parties involved.

Highways England have also produced a draft SOCG with Derby City Council, which is at an advanced stage, but is subject to review and comment by both parties. Highways England hope to be in a position to submit a draft version for Deadline 3.

In addition, Highways England can advise that Western Power Distribution Ltd (as a Statutory Undertaker) have declined to enter into the production of a Statement of Common Ground in respect of this application.

Finally, Highways England can confirm that they are currently in discussions with a number of other parties in relation to the production of a Statements of Common Ground, which do not form part of the formal request by the Examining Authority for Deadline 1. As such, these comprise:

Sustrans and Derby Cycling Group Breadsall Parish Council

A draft Statement of Common Ground has been agreed with Little Eaton Parish Council and is included in this submission. Highways England anticipate that the others listed above will be available for Deadline 3.

## Other Documentation

In respect of the request for an updated Book of Reference and Statement of Reasons, Highways England can confirm that there are no substantive changes to either document to report at this stage and as such, updated documents are not being provided. Any updates to both documents will be separately recorded during the examination period and updated versions of these documents will be included in the submission for Deadline 6.

To assist the Examining Authority, a schedule is enclosed as part of this submission, which details the changes to the Book of Reference from the version (v2 dated July





2019) submitted to the Planning Inspectorate following advice under Section 51 of the Planning Act 2008.

## **Future submissions**

The Examining Authority will note that some of the response to the first written questions refer to documentation that will be provided for future deadlines. These are referred to below.

- Q 1.4 Update works plans amendment to the annotation of Work No 26d will be provided for Deadline 2.
- Q 9.8 Verified visual montages This work is currently being prepared and will be provided for Deadline 2.

- Q9.14 Kingsway Junction northern dumbbell A cross sectional drawing will be provided for Deadline 2.
- Q9.19 Figure 7.1A Viewpoint 10 An updated figure will be provided for Deadline 2.
- Q9.32 Landscape Character Areas submission of updated tables will be provided for Deadline 2.

## **Guide to the Application**

Highways England have produced a new document for Deadline 1 referred to as the 'Guide to the Application.' This document has been produced to manage the document control process during the examination period. It covers documentation that has been updated since the original DCO submission was made and also identifies any new documents provided, along with tracking any subsequent revision to those documents.
