



Application by Highways England for an Order Granting Development Consent for the A38 Derby Junctions Scheme

The Examining Authority's (ExA) Record of the Third Unaccompanied Site Inspection

The ExA undertook the inspection by car and on foot on public roads and public rights of way. The route was planned in response to concerns expressed at Issue Specific Hearing 3 regarding flooding in the area and enabled the ExA to obtain views of the application sites and surrounding areas.

18 February 2020	15.35-15.45	Moderate visibility. Light rain.	By car via A38 to Kingsway junction to view Bramble Brook.
