Statements of Common Ground

The ExA will note that there are some items within the Statement of Common Ground (SoCG) with Breadsall Parish Council that are marked as 'Not Agreed' and one item that is

'Under Discussion.' This item has been marked as 'Under Discussion' at the specific request of Breadsall Parish Council. In relation to the under discussion item, Highways England considers it has taken all relevant factors into consideration and there is nothing further to add beyond the content of the SoCG. Notwithstanding this, there is a further opportunity for potential refinement at the detailed design stage. As such, Highways England does not anticipate a further update to the SoCG during the examination and the version submitted at deadline 8 should be treated as the final version.

In relation to the SoCGs with the Royal School for the Deaf, Derby and Sutton Turner Houses, Highways England would also wish to highlight that these documents contain items that are 'Not Agreed' or are 'Under Discussion.' Notwithstanding this, Highways England can confirm that there is nothing further that can be added beyond the current versions. As such, these documents should also be treated as the final versions for the purpose of the examination.

The documents have been submitted in PDF format.

In respect of the list of documents referred to above, where needed and particularly for documents that have not been requested by the ExA, further explanation is provided within the document as to its purpose and the reason for the submission.
