The Planning Act 2008 and The Infrastructure Planning (Examination Procedure) Rules 2010 – Rule 17 Request for Further Information

Application by Highways England for an Order Granting Development Consent for the A38 Derby Junctions project

In our letter of 3 April 2020, we updated the Examination Timetable in light of the public health situation and disruption caused by the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic. In that letter we also provided initial information on the proposed new arrangements for the rest of the Examination. We also said that we would be requesting representations on the new arrangements.

We are considering how best to examine the remaining issues and how best to ensure fairness given the practical constraints that we all currently face. The Examination is primarily a written process and that process will continue. However, we have not yet decided whether there will be any further Hearings and, if any are held, what the arrangements and preparations for those should be.
