1.7 – Given the additional wording set out in PW-WAT1, we are content that the OEMP provides sufficient measures to protect controlled waters in the vicinity of the main construction compound. These measures set out protective actions which will be included within the preliminary works CEMP, and will include consultation with the Environment Agency.
