Derbyshire Bat Conservation group have concerns about this proposed work. 10 of the 12 species of bats known to be in Derbshire have been recorded in Markeaton Park, and in the area specifically impacted by the work. Some of the mature trees along the carriageway are known bat roosts, which would usually be protected under the Wildlife and Countryside Act and other wildlife legislation. Although some mitigation is planned, nothing can replace the suitability of these veteran trees. We would also have concerns about the impact of increased pollution and emissions on the remaining trees and wildlife.
