Application by Suffolk County Council for an Order Granting Development Consent for the Lake Lothing Third Crossing

Notification of hearings and Accompanied Site Inspection

We write to all Interested Parties to announce the dates, times and places of forthcoming hearings which will be held between 13 and 15 February 2019, and the date, time and meeting place for an Accompanied Site Inspection on 12 February 2019. Important details about both are set out at **Annex A, Annex B** and **Annex C** to this letter, respectively.

### **Hearings**

As set out in the Examination Timetable annexed to our Rule 8 letter dated 17 December 2018, those Interested Parties who wish to speak at a further Open Floor Hearing (OFH) or at a Compulsory Acquisition Hearing (CAH) were asked to notify the Planning Inspectorate by 4 January 2019 (Deadline 2). At least one request was also received from an Affected Person to be heard at a CAH, and consequentially such a hearing must also be held. We established in Annex B to our Rule 8 letter that at least one further OFH would be held in the course of the Examination. We have also decided to hold hearings on specific issues. Details of and arrangements for these hearings are set out at **Annex A**.

We should be grateful if you would inform us if you plan to attend any of the hearings (even if you do not wish to speak) **no later than 6 February 2019**. It would also assist us if you could notify the Planning Inspectorate's Case Team of any special requirements you may have (eg disabled access, hearing loop etc). Please ensure that you include your Interested Party reference number in your correspondence (provided either in the email covering this letter or on the postcard you have received). An agenda for each of the hearings will be published on our website in the week before each event.



### **Accompanied Site Inspection**

As set out in the Examination Timetable annexed to our Rule 8 letter dated 17 December 2018, those Interested Parties who wish to attend the Accompanied Site Inspection (ASI) were asked to notify the Planning Inspectorate by 4 January 2019 (Deadline 2).

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## Final Itinerary for Accompanied Site Inspection

1.1.1 The date, time and place of the accompanied site inspection ('ASI') will be:

Date: 12 February 2019

Arrival time: 9.30am

Departure Time: 10.00am

**Meeting Place**: Northern landing point of the scheme situated on the south side of the roundabout at the junction of Denmark Road, Peto Way and Rotterdam Road. Locally known as the old coal yard site. Note: An area will be coned off to provide parking for those attending the ASI.

### 1.2 Transport

1.2.1 Parties should make their own arrangements for travel to the ASI meeting place (location is as advised above). A small coach will be provided for travel during the ASI itself and will return to the Northern landing point at the end of the ASI.

### 1.3 Health and Safety

- 1.3.1 Each person attending the ASI is responsible for his or her own health and safety at the time. If you feel your health or safety to be prejudiced during the visit, you should let the Examining Authority know immediately. ABP will be responsible for health and safety on visiting their locations.
- 1.3.2 ABP require visitors to wear personal protective equipment ('PPE'): if you own protective boots, a hard hat and a high visibility jacket, please bring these with you. A small quantity of PPE will be available, but on a first come first served basis.
- 1.3.3 The locations that the ASI will include, and the order in which they are proposed to be viewed, are as follows:

### 1.4 Itinerary






Figure 2a – Locations within the Port of Lowestoft (circled) (base map from ABP)

- 1.4.1 Please see a suggested route in Figure 1, which follows the order of locations listed below. Figure 2 highlights areas within the Port.
- 1.4.2 Please note a non-stop driving tour of this route would be approximately 1 hour, hence 3 hours is suggested to take account of stops;
  - 1) Northern Landing Site, including Rotterdam Road roundabout to view Network Rail assets and means of access and site in general;
  - 2) Port of Lowestoft: At the request of ABP includes;
  - a) The Outer Harbour Hamilton Dock;
  - b) The Inner Harbour via Commercial Road, including;
    - (i) The Shell Base site (upstream of the Scheme);
    - (ii) East of ABP warehouse (Shed 3), to view the point at which the Scheme crosses the Port;



### (iii) Town Quay;

- 3) Millennium Way/A47 Roundabout, the start of the northern link towards the Scheme;
- 4) Mutford Bridge Oulton Broad, context of existing crossing;
- 5) Bloodmoor Road Roundabout, the start of the southern link towards the Scheme;
- 6) Lowestoft Haven Marina, at request of the Navigation Working Group;
- 7) Southern Landing Side including Riverside Business Park, Durban Road and Waveney Drive including opportunity to view land/premises owned/occupied by Lings, Nexen, Statuslist, Northumbrian Water [including internal inspection of Trinity House], Waveney District Council and Suffolk County Council;
- 8) A47 Bascule Bridge, context of existing crossing; and
- 9) Northern Landing Site (return to carpark)
