Further to the Examining Authority's ('ExA') letter of 4 February 2019 issued pursuant to Rule 8 of the Infrastructure Planning (Examination Procedure) Rules 2010 ('the Rule 8 Letter'), the purpose of this letter is to provide an overview of Suffolk County Council's ('the Applicant' / 'SCC') submissions required by the ExA at Deadline 6 of the Examination.

Deadline 6 submissions

As outlined in the Report on proposed Non-Material Changes to the Application (Document Reference SCC/LLTC/EX/69, PINS Reference REP4-013) the Applicant has undertaken a consultation on the eight proposed non-material changes to the Scheme.

The additional non-statutory consultation ran from Friday 1 February 2019 to Monday 4 March 2019, allowing consultees a period within which to consider the Applicant's Proposed Changes Application. The Applicant has received 7 responses to that consultation.

One of the proposed changes – the addition of a new turning head at the eastern end of Canning Road (NMC1) – requires the additional permanent acquisition of a small area of land. Requests for the written consent to this proposal in particular have been sent to all five parties with an interest in the relevant land.

In the enclosed document SCC/LLTC/EX/89, the Applicant includes copies of all 7 consultation responses received within the consultation response period, and of the written consents (currently 4 out of 5) required in respect of NMC1. The Applicant continues to seek confirmation of the one remaining outstanding consent, which is sought from Homes

England (the Homes and Communities Agency). The Applicant will provide a further update in this regard as soon as it is able to.
