Deadline 8 Submissions (12 April 2019)

All other sections of this report remain unchanged, and therefore this report should be read alongside the Applicant's previous submissions. The Applicant provided a draft of the updated report to ABP and has had regard to its feedback on this section 5.2 before submitting this updated version. No consequential update of the Vessel Survey Report (REP3-60) is submitted, due to the fact that the data that is presented in that report is not affected by the GMT/BST anomaly owing to the way the data is aggregated in that report |
