We write on behalf of Northumbrian Water Limited (NWL).

Further to our brief written submission at Deadline 10, we can now confirm that an agreement has been reached between NWL and the Applicant (SCC). This addresses the remaining concerns of NWL as set out in prior written representations, including those relating to noise effects on Trinity House, and specific arrangements relating to the NWL land interests, and construction-related liaison.

We further note the release on 29 May 2019 of the Examining Authority's draft DCO, and wish to raise no further comments on the proposed drafting.

Based on the above, and the Applicant not seeking to further amend any of the relevant sections of the draft DCO, NWL's objections to the Scheme can therefore be considered to be withdrawn.
