THE PLANNING ACT 2008 - LAKE LOTHING THIRD CROSSING, LOWESTOFT ORDER - EXAMINING AUTHORITY'S DRAFT DEVELOPMENT CONSENT ORDER

The Marine Management Organisation (MMO) received notification of the publication of the Examining Authority's (ExA) draft Development Consent Order (DCO) for the Lake Lothing Third Crossing, Lowestoft Order 29 May 2019.

The draft DCO includes a Deemed Marine Licence (DML) under Section 65 of the Marine and Coastal Access Act 2009 (MCAA 2009). Should consent be granted for the proposed development, the MMO will be responsible for monitoring, compliance and enforcement of DML conditions.

As an Interested Party in the proposed development, I am writing to inform you that the MMO has now completed its review of the ExA's draft DCO. Under this review, particular attention was paid to the following sections, as they are considered to be directly relevant to the interests of the MMO:

- Part 2(5), Limits of Deviation
- Schedule 12, Deemed Marine Licence

Following our review, I am pleased to inform you that the MMO is of the opinion that the ExA's draft DCO is acceptable. Whilst the ExA has made a number of amendments to the Applicant's draft DCO, as submitted under Deadline 10, the MMO does not consider these changes to have significantly altered, or adversely affected, the scope and content of the document agreed with the Applicant under the final Statement of Common Ground (document reference: SCC/LLTC/EX/112).

The MMO reserves the right to modify its present advice, or opinion, in view of any additional matters or information that may come to our attention.
