4. Confirming why the Planning Inspectorate should receive the application



* Brief statement to explain why this application is, or is to be treated as, a development for which development consent is required under the Planning Act 2008

This application for development consent has been submitted by Highways England for the provision of the proposed A19 Downhill Lane Junction Improvement at South Tyneside and Sunderland, Tyne and Wear.

The Scheme is an NSIP within Sections 14(1)(h) and 22 (1)(b) of the Planning Act 2008. Under Section 22 an NSIP must fall within one of the three categories specified, which are expressly stated to be alternatives. This Scheme is an "alteration" within the meaning of Section 22(1)(b). The alteration is to the A19 Downhill Lane Junction with the addition of a new bridge south of the existing bridge to form a more traditional roundabout junction layout above the A19. The Scheme satisfies Section 22(3)(a) and (b) in that all the highway involved is wholly in England and Highways England Company Ltd, being a strategic highways authority, is the highway authority for the A19. The relevant area for development under Section 22(3) (c) and (4) is 12.5 hectares because the highway being altered is a highway, other than a motorway, where the speed limit for any class of vehicle is expected to be 50 miles per hour or greater. Plans TR010024/APP/2.3(A) to 2.3(D) show the area for development, namely "the land on which the part of the highway to be altered is situated and any adjoining land expected to be used in connection with its alteration". The area for development (excluding the construction compound at Testo's) is 30.68 hectares, which thereby exceeds the hectare threshold. The area of development including the construction compound at Testo's is 36.81 hectares.

5. Non-technical description of the Proposed Development



* Brief non-technical description of the Proposed Development

The Scheme comprises:

- · Construction of a new bridge south of the existing bridge.
- Together with the existing bridge this will form a more traditional roundabout junction layout above the A19.
- The existing north-bound and south-bound A19 slip roads will be realigned to tie in with the new elevated roundabout arrangement.
- To the north of the junction, these will serve as link roads between Downhill Lane Junction and the proposed new Testo's junction roundabout.
- The slip roads south of the junction will also be realigned but will continue to provide direct access to and from the A19.
- On the west side of the junction the A1290 will be re-aligned and to the east, the layout of Downhill Lane and Washington Road will also be amended to suit the new junction.

A full description of the Scheme can be found in Chapter 2 of the Environmental Statement (Document reference TR010024/APP/6.1).

6. Location or route of the Proposed Development

The proposed development is in the North East of England and is located in the administrative areas of South Tyneside Council and Sunderland Council. The site is located on the A19 dual carriageway at Downhill Lane Junction. The A19 is the main strategic highway route to Tyne Tunnel and a key trade link to the Port of Tyne and the Port of Sunderland.

The location of the application site is shown on the Location Plan (Document reference TR010024/APP/2.1) and the alterations to the junction is shown on the Scheme Layout Plan (Document reference TR010024/APP/2.2). A detailed description of the location of the Scheme is provided in Chapter 2 of the Environmental Statement
