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1 INTRODUCTION

1.1 Introduction

- 1.1.1 This document provides a guide to Highway England's A19 Downhill Lane Junction Improvement (the Scheme) Development Consent Order application pursuant to the Planning Act 2008. The application was submitted to the Planning Inspectorate on the 25th January 2019.
- 1.1.2 Since submission, a number of the original application documents have been revised and new documents produced. This guide charts the submission of these documents to the Planning Inspectorate.
- 1.1.3 This is a live document and will be updated throughout the examination period and submitted, when updated, for each deadline.

5	Consultation Report and Related Documents	Details of the pre-application consultation that Highways England has undertaken on the Scheme and how consultation feedback has been taken into account.	
6	Environmental Statement and Related Documents	An assessment of the likely significant effects (both positive and negative) of the Scheme on the environment and a description of mitigation measures proposed to reduce any negative impacts.	
7	Other Documents	Additional documents that support the DCO application; these are not legally required but provide useful information on the case for the Scheme and/or do not fall into the categories above, including the Transport Assessment.
