1 INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 This Location Plan (this "Plan") relates to an application made by Highways England (the "Applicant") to the Planning Inspectorate ("the Inspectorate") under section 37 of the Planning Act 2008 (the "2008 Act") for a Development Consent Order (DCO). If made, the DCO would grant consent for the Applicant to undertake the A19 Downhill Lane Junction Improvement (the "Scheme"). A detailed description of the Scheme can be found in the Environmental Statement (Application Document Reference: TR010024/APP/6.1)
- 1.2 This Plan comprises part of the suite of Application documentation and is included in the Application in compliance with Regulation 5(2)(o) of the Infrastructure Planning (Applications: Prescribed Forms and Procedure) Regulations 2009, which requires:
 - "5(2)(o) any other plans, drawings and sections necessary to describe the proposals for which development consent is sought, showing details of design, external appearance, and the preferred layout of buildings or structures, drainage, surface water management, means of vehicular and pedestrian access, any car parking to be provided, and means of landscaping:"
- 1.3 Although Regulation 5(2)(o) does not expressly mention location, the Planning Inspectorate's Advice note six: Preparation and submission of application documents (February 2016: version 7) suggests (at Appendix 1) that an application for development consent may include the submission of a location plan under Regulation 5(2)(o).
- 1.4 This Plan therefore has been included in the Application to identify the location of the proposed development in its wider geographical context. As a consequence, this plan uses a smaller scale than that prescribed in Regulation 5(3) of the Infrastructure Planning (Applications: Prescribed Forms and Procedure) Regulations 2009, but only so that this wider geographical context can be represented on a single sheet plan.
- 1.5 As this Plan is part of the Application documentation, it should be read alongside and is informed by the other Application documents.
