SOUTH TYNESIDE COUNCIL (ST SIMON STREET, SOUTH SHIELDS) ORDER 2019

On 12 September 2019 South Tyneside Council made an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers. The Order which comes into operation on 23 September 2019 will introduce a Restricted Parking Zone - No Waiting Monday to Friday 8.30am to 9.30am and 2.30pm to 3.30pm except in designated Parking Bays on St Simon St east side (i) from a point 58m southeast of its junction with Winskill Rd in a south eastwards then north eastwards direction for a distance of 40m (ii) from a point 98m southeast of its junction with Winskill Rd in a south eastwards direction for a distance of 13m and on north side (i) from a point 81m southeast of its junction with Winskill Rd in a south westwards then south eastwards direction for a distance of 55m (ii) from a point 122m southeast then northeast of its junction with Winskill Rd in a north eastwards then northwards direction for a distance of 39m (iii) from a point 179m southeast then northeast of its junction with Winskill Rd in a south westwards then north westwards then south westwards then south eastwards direction for a distance of 31m and on south side (i) from a point 89m southeast of its junction with Winskill Rd in a north westwards then south westwards then south eastwards then south westwards direction for a distance of 71m (ii) from a point 103m southeast of its junction with Winskill Rd in a north eastwards direction for a distance of 82m.

Full details are contained in the Order, which together with a plan showing the lengths of road affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order, may be inspected from Mon to Fri during normal office hours at the Town Hall at the address below (LS15945). Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Act or that any of the requirements of the Act or of any relevant regulations made under the Act have not been complied with may, within 6 weeks from 12 September 2019 when the Order was made, make an application for that purpose to the High Court.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, at the dates, times and locations set out below, a compulsory acquisition hearing and an issue specific hearing will be held by the Examining Authority (appointed by the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government) for the examination of the application made by Highways England for a Development Consent Order ("the DCO") for the A19 Downhill Lane Junction Improvement Scheme ("the Application"). The Application was made to the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government (via the Planning Inspectorate) under sections 14, 22 and 37 of the Planning Act 2008 on 25 January 2019 and was accepted by the Planning Inspectorate for examination on 22 February 2019. The Application has been given the Planning Inspectorate reference number TR010024.

SUMMARY OF THE SCHEME

The Application seeks development consent for the A19 Downhill Lane junction improvement in the North East region, located within the administrative areas of South Tyneside and Sunderland (the "Scheme").

The main aspects of the Scheme comprise the following:

- Construction of a new bridge south of the existing bridge.
- Together with the existing bridge, this will form a more traditional roundabout junction layout above the A19.
- The existing north-bound and south-bound A19 slip roads will be realigned to tie in with the new elevated roundabout arrangement.
- To the north of the junction, these will serve as link roads between Downhill Lane Junction and the proposed new Testo's junction roundabout.
- The slip roads south of the junction will also be realigned but will continue to provide direct access to and from the A19.
- On the west side of the junction the A1290 will be re-aligned and to the east, the layout of Downhill Lane and Washington Road will also be amended to suit the new junction.
- Temporary access roads, temporary highways works, temporary construction compounds and work sites will be required during construction of the Scheme.
- Provision of a new route for pedestrians, cyclists and walkers.

If the DCO is made by the Secretary of State for Transport, it would allow Highways England, for the purpose of constructing, operating and maintaining the Scheme, to acquire compulsorily interests in and rights over land, including the power to create and acquire new rights over land, and to take possession of and to use land temporarily.

The DCO would also make provision for development, which would constitute associated development together with other ancillary matters, including those related to the temporary and permanent stopping up of highways in the vicinity of the Scheme; and the temporary and permanent stopping up of private means of access in the vicinity of the Scheme.

HEARINGS

The Examining Authority's letter dated 21 August 2019 contains a programme for the examination of the Application, including a number of hearings. Those hearings taking place in October 2019 will be held at the dates, times and locations set out in the table below.
