We are writing to let you know about the start of the statutory consulta proposed A303 Stonehenge: Amesbury to Berwick Down scheme nationally significant infrastructure project under the Planning Act 2008.

Following on from the previous public consultation in January 2017 and the route announcement in September 2017, Highways England is proposing the A303 past Stonehenge between Amesbury and Berwick Down to a dual control of the cont



- A new junction between the A303 and A360 to the west of and Stonehenge, Avebury and Associated Sites World Heritage Site Heritage Site), replacing the existing Longbarrow roundabout;
- A twin-bore tunnel at least 1.8 miles (2.9 km) long past Stoneheng
- A new junction between the A303 and A345 at the site of Countess roundabout;
