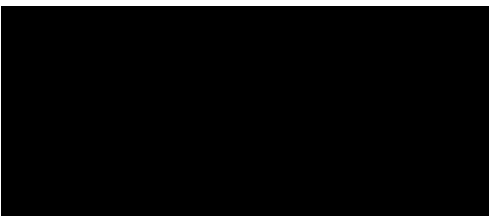
Response from South Oxfordshire and Vale of White Horse Councils
