Participation, conduct and management of hearings

At an Open Floor Hearing, each Interested Party is entitled (subject to the ExA's powers of control over the conduct of the hearing) to make oral representations about the application.

The ExA may request those who wish to speak on the same topic to select one person to put forward their views.

Each Interested Party should assume that they will be allowed a **maximum speaking time of 5 minutes** in total for all submissions that they wish to make in these sessions. Please note that in the event that there are an exceptional number of potential submissions, it may be necessary to be more restrictive.

If on the day there are other individuals present who wish to make submissions that have not already been made it will be open to the ExA to use its discretion to hear any relevant submissions from those present should time permit.

It would also assist the ExA if copies of any written summaries of the cases put orally are submitted to the Planning Inspectorate by **Deadline 3** (31 May 2019) in the Examination Timetable at **Annex A** to the Rule 8 letter¹.

Please note that the following agenda is indicative and may be amended by the ExA at the start of the hearing session.

1.	Welcome, introductions and arrangements for the hearing
2.	Purpose of the Open Floor Hearing
3.	Confirmation of those who have notified the Examining Authority (ExA) of a wish to be heard at the Open Floor Hearing
4.	<p>Oral submissions from Interested Parties</p> <p>Each Interested Party who has indicated a wish to speak will be invited forward in turn to speak at a table set up in front of the ExA.</p> <p>Following each submission the ExA may wish to ask the speaker questions.</p> <p>The Applicant is likely to be requested to briefly respond to any matters raised by each of the Interested Parties or in summary at the close of each Open Floor Hearing.</p> <p>Oral submissions should be based on representations previously made in writing by the particular participant. However, representations made at the hearing should not simply repeat matters previously covered in a written submission, but rather provide further detail, explanation and evidential corroboration to help inform the ExA.</p>
